The meeting was called to order at 9:38am. A motion was made to approve the May 2010 minutes. Welcome new One Rox Participant and Rox State Park Manager, Todd Farrow.

County Update

Steve Boand is moderating a statewide County Commissioner water supply panel this morning in Vail and is not able to attend the One Rox meeting today. Commissioner Boand's report is as follows:

- The BoCC has met twice in the last month with Lockheed Marietta officials to build the relationships needed for major roadway improvement coming in future years. OK - we got to see some really cool high tech stuff too, but that is just a perk. We have also met with the JeffCo County Commissioners on joint issues.
- The BoCC met with CDOT officials two weeks ago to convey Douglas County's priority list for highway improvements. C-470 and Santa Fe were the top two requests (as always). The Santa Fe/C-470 interchange project continues to move toward construction. The contractor/bid has been approved and DougCo has fully funded its obligations. CDOT is, though, working a right-of-way issue that we were not aware of until last week. The County put up another 250k to help resolve the problem.
- I will be asking for two water quality tests to be completed relative to the Foothills Treat Plant issue. The reports filed to date reflect good work regarding the surface investigations.
- Work continues on the Rox EEE. We are completing some historical investigations this month on the stage road issue. The project team has recommended that we use Plum Creek gravel to match the colors in the Rox area. I strongly support that outcome. Larry Moore stated concerns from Ed Fox regarding the impact to the red rocks in the State Park. Mr. Fox was proposing a change in path of the road. Open house forums were offered early on and that is when input should have been included.
- Regarding the request to the USPS to add Roxborough to the 80125 zip code, Commissioner Boand has committed to draft a letter of support to put before the Commissioners for consideration next week.
- Happy Summer to All. Be safe and enjoy Colorado.

New Business

Roxborough, CO address: Sean B submitted a letter on behalf of One Roxborough to the USPS to request an addition of to the 80125 zip code.

Water Board: Larry M announced that Kelly Boyle has resigned her position from the Roxborough Water & Sanitation District Board due to work-related constraints. The Water Board will consider the next in line for # of votes on the most recent ballot, John Dillon, to fill Kelly's position. Emergency Preparedness: Fran reported that Denver Water (Brian Good) has come to the table to partner with a first responders Emergency Preparedness plan in conjunction with the local schools in Roxborough; a full-scale Emergency Preparedness drill will take place on October 6th; a table top session will be offered to encourage discussions of impacts in the case of an emergency; shelter-in-place community training will also be offered; the Strontia Springs plan is being updated; just completed exercise with Pike National Forest regarding the marijuana grows.

Roxborough Village Metro District: no report

Hands Across Roxborough: Dave Jarboe introduced Carlene Harris; she will be responsible for the Community Carnival; Dave reported that the community pulled together to raise money for Andy Marquez and his wife, Teresa, and for their recovery; the Community rallied to raise roughly \$9,200 dollars to help with medical bills. Lu Mahan was key in "rallying the troops" for the Marquez fundraiser. The family will lose their Art Gallery. Rox Community Carnival: Carlene provided a handout for the July 3rd carnival.

Roxborough Marketplace Business Association: starting a Roxborough Chamber of Commerce; open house scheduled for Tue, June 8th, 4-7pm at Perella's; presentation at 5:30pm.

PTIC: raised \$105k for the 2009-2010 school year; the \$\$ will go to support educational programs, science teacher, educational aids and technology at the local schools; BAM BAM is holding a golf tournament Aug 29th; launched a sister pta-like organization called the RVMS P.I.T. Crew at Ranch View Middle School.

RatPak: roughly 55 kids participated in the last few meetings; seeking mentors to assist with RatPak meetings; time commitment consists of 1.5 hours for nine meetings per year.

Roxborough Elementary: June 3rd last school day for RXP; June 4th last school day for RXI; 6th grade Continuation, Kindie Graduation programs taking place; the school is packing in preparation for remodel construction.

Douglas County Libraries: summer reading program underway; good giver-aways to kids who participate and complete the program; DC Libraries hosted the school classrooms at the library.

Roxborough Park Foundation: the Board decided to remove all speed humps in the neighborhood; the Board will continue to monitor; an art show is taking place this weekend at Haney Park and the Rox Park Community Center.

Sterling Ranch: existing zoning; filed to add an additional 450 acres; working on amendments; changing paradigm on development and the approach; consideration for the development of the future approach; are building new partnerships for a community development; demolished old structures; kept grazing off of site and re-introducing grazing for early summer; working with Colorado Nature & Science regarding land preservation and augmenting Lamb Springs area.

4H Club: two garage sales and a bake sale taking place; adopted Art Council design for the Roxborough Renegade shirts for 4H; meeting tomorrow night for project demonstration



Rox Art Council: Art Council has had a very busy Spring; murals in the Rox Marketplace Clock tower structure look fantastic; Stacie Robinson and Patricia Jenkins created the beautiful mural; in exchange for the murals, Sunset Mgmt has provided a gallery in the Marketplace, operating hours are 10am-7pm, Wed-Sun; all volunteer staffed and all proceeds go 100% to the artist
