## **I. Announcements**

- ❖ **One Roxborough Elections:** Sean Burke has been elected Co-Chair of One Roxborough and Kelly Boyle has been elected as Co-Chair and Secretary for One Roxborough. Sean will serve a 1 year term and Kelly will serve a 2 year term.
- ❖ **Douglas County Libraries:** Shelly Stevens (Roxborough Resident) spoke on behalf of the Douglas County Library system to help us all understand the many benefits we receive from Douglas County Libraries and the very low cost per household to County Residents. Shelly stated that she is here speaking with One Rox to elevate consciousness and to promote literacy. Shelly inspired us with a quote: “I’ve learned that what we have done for ourselves alone dies with us. What we have done for others and the world remains and is immortal.”-- Albert Pike.**Emergency Preparedness:** Fran reported that the Emergency Preparedness training exercise that took place on April 10th was a big success. The training received and the information learned during the drill was key to future planning and preparedness, including an issue regarding the EverBridge emergency alert/reverse 911 system.
- ❖ **Hands Across Roxborough:** Andy & Theresa Marquez both have major health conditions. A fundraiser to support the Marquez family will be held on May 23rd, 5-8pm at the Rox



Marketplace Clocktower. The Roxborough Community Carnival will be held in the Marketplace on July 3rd, 5-9pm.

- ❖ **Perella's:** Rob announced that he and some other business owners in the area are starting a Roxborough-Chatfield Valley Community Association. The first meeting will be held on Friday, May 14th, 8:30am in the Roxborough Library, Lockheed Martin Conference Room. The business group will be working with the Highlands Ranch Chamber of Commerce to help the group to get off the ground.
  
- ❖ **State Parks:** Scott Roush is the new Manager of Chatfield State Park and Todd Farrow is the new Manager of Roxborough State Park.
  
- ❖ **4H Club:** Meetings are at 6pm on the first Friday of every month at the Rox Park Community Center; a bake sale will be held at Chase Bank in HR and also at Little People's Landing; working on t-shirts; a garage sale planned for this summer as well as a camp-out at Chatfield State Park; the belt buckle donations program is closed off and the horse steering committee will fund the difference of what funds are needed.
  
- ❖ **Sterling Ranch:** an addendum has been submitted to the County for an additional 400+ acres to the plan; calves will be back on the property in about 2 weeks after the land sat vacant for a year to let the land recoup.
  
- ❖ **Roxborough Elementary:** Jammie Jamborree was a huge success and expect more kids to participate next year; school construction for the remodel of the Primary building is underway and expected to be completed in October; funds for the construction were committed from the 2006 bond mill; some of the CSAP scores have been posted; Rick reported that the CSAP reading scores increased by 12% which is a huge gain
  
- ❖ **Rox Art Council:** "Spring Forward" show is currently taking place at the Rox Fire Station; a reception will be held on May 15th from 2-5pm to meet the artists; the RAC now has 42 members; Patricia Jenkins has been working with Alan Fishman from the Roxborough Marketplace to open an art gallery in the Marketplace; Alan will donate the space and the Rox Art Council will be painting the staircase of the clock-tower; a small Art Gallery and classes will be held in the gallery space; target opening date is June 1st; reception will be held the 2nd Friday of each month 5-8 pm at the gallery.
- ❖ **Douglas County:** The County Commissioners received two reports on the Foothills Water Treatment Plant issue last Friday. The reports generally indicate there are no asbestos issues.



We are reviewing them carefully next week to make sure all the bases have been covered and that the on-site investigations and monitoring data reasonably reflect the issues raised in the initial news reports.

Congratulations to the new members of the Roxborough Village Metro District and the Roxborough Water & Sanitation District. We all have important work to coordinate and complete by year end.

The Roxborough Town meeting on Tuesday evening went well. There was good discussion regarding bicycle safety issues and a couple of near term road projects that may affect neighborhoods later this year. Several 1Rox members were present and may have comments to add.

The Ravenna Metro District has request pending before the County regarding their service plan. They are asking for an opinion that the issuance of a \$7 million note to the development company does not require an update of their Service Plan.

The Roxborough EEE is on schedule for completion in October. I remain wary of the County's construction of the portion of the EEE through the Park and am hoping for the best. I believe that we have developed a good plan but this will be a change to the character of Roxborough State Park. I remain of the opinion that the shorter EEE route would have been a better choice.
